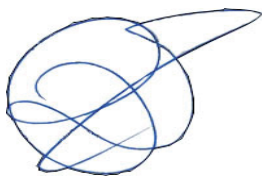
Every medical profession is recognized by its diagnostics, every patient has a need to be recognized with his complaints, every student needs to recognize his osteopathic examination.

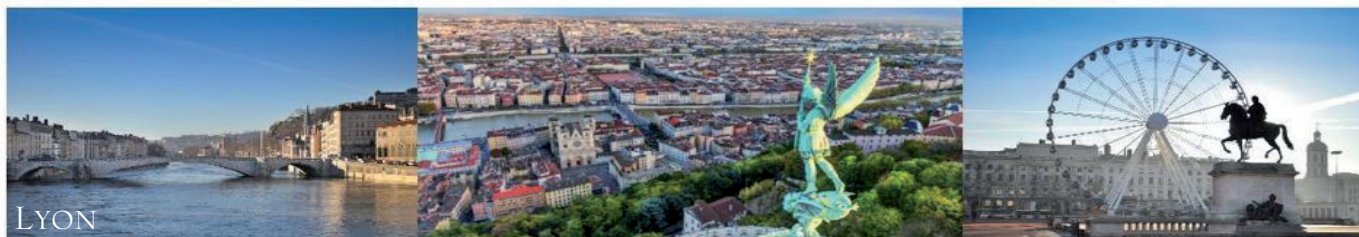
OsEAN is a group of like-minded osteopathic educational institutions with a common mission:

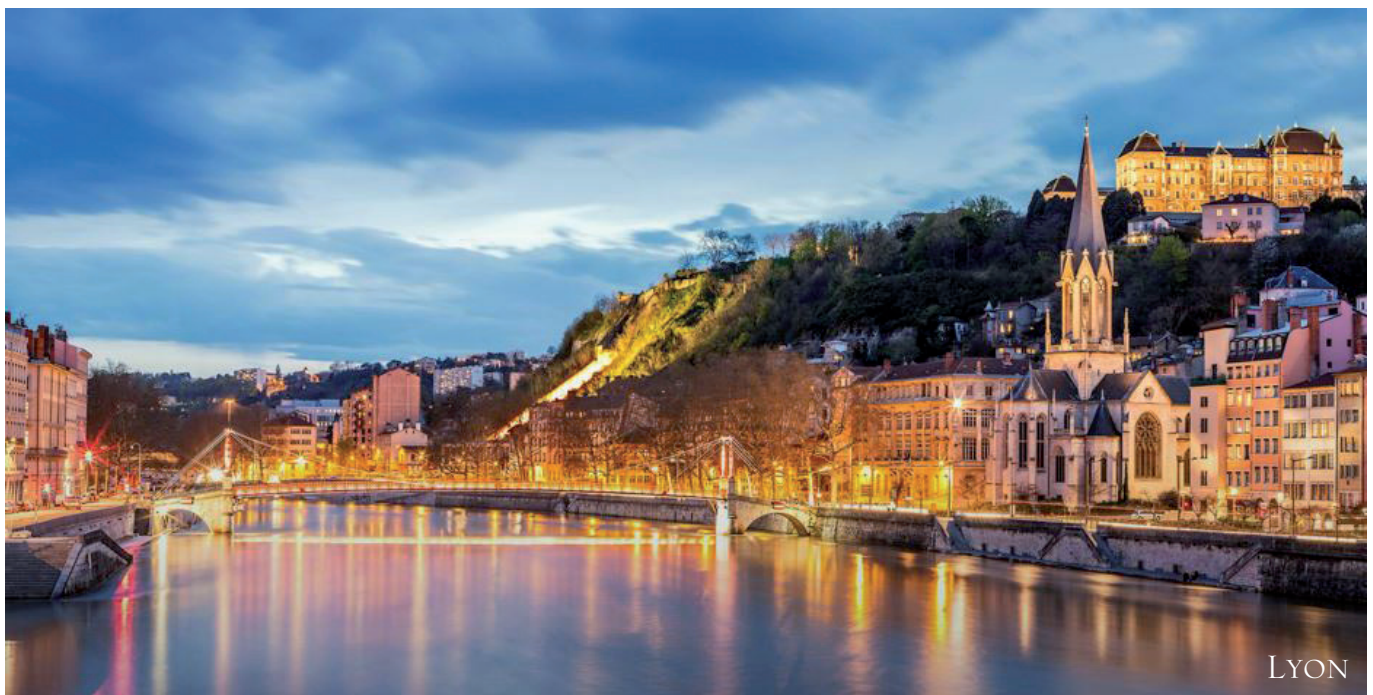
